- Ensuring students have placed their actual device inside. This can be cross-checked using the school's pouch tracking spreadsheet.

4. Promote Positive Reinforcement

Recognise and commend students who consistently follow the policy. Reinforcement goes a long way in building habits.

5. Engage in Training & Dialogue

Attend briefings and training sessions on the system. Share classroom insights with the Senior Leadership Team (SLT) to help adapt and improve the implementation.

6. Report Issues Early

Flag any issues (e.g. refusals, damaged pouches, students forgetting their phones) to the designated policy lead. A structured response, including parent contact and possible sanctions, will be in place.
